

# FREE OR 50% COST-SHARE WATER TREATMENT

Dakota County has grant funding to help well owners with the expense of drinking water treatment devices to reduce nitrate, lead, arsenic, manganese and coliform bacteria. To be eligible for this MDH Safe Drinking Water Grant the well user must have all of the following criteria:

1. Use a private well as the primary source of drinking water for a residence in Dakota County.
2. Have a water test for the five contaminants newer than July 2024.
3. Have at least one contaminant above the grant drinking water guidelines.
4. Meet USDA Rural Development Low Income if requesting 100% reimbursement. No income information is required if only requesting 50% reimbursement.

Contaminant	Drinking Water Guideline
Arsenic	2 µg/L (micrograms per liter)
Manganese	0.100 mg/L (milligrams per liter)
Nitrate	10 mg/L (milligrams per liter)
Coliform Bacteria	Any detection
Lead	Any detection
